



# Something Special For the Lady A's

## <u>Fresh Corn Tomato Salad - Food Network</u>

3 tablespoons white wine vinegar Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper 1/4 cup extra-virgin olive oil

6 ears fresh corn

2 cups red or orange grape tomatoes, halved

8 ounces fresh mozzarella, cut into small cubes

1 bunch scallions (white and green), thinly sliced

1 1/2 cups fresh basil leaves



Whisk together the vinegar, 2 teaspoons salt and some pepper in a small bowl. Gradually whisk in the oil, starting with a few drops and then adding the rest in a steady stream, to make a smooth dressing. Shear off the corn kernels with a sharp knife over a bowl (you should have about 4 cups). Toss in the tomatoes, mozzarella and scallions. Pour the vinaigrette over the salad and toss to coat. Cover and let stand for at least 15 minutes and up to 2 hours. Before serving, tear the basil over the salad and stir to combine.

## Three-Ingredient Brownies - Ree Drummon "Pioneer Woman" - Food Network


Nonstick cooking spray, for spraying the pan

2 1/2 cups chocolate-hazelnut spread, such as Nutella

1 heaping cup all-purpose flour

3 large eggs

Preheat the oven to  $350^\circ$ ; spray a 9x13 pan with nonstick cooking spray. In a medium bowl, stir together the chocolate-hazelnut spread, flour and eggs. Pour into the prepared pan & spread the mixture to the edges. Bake until the surface looks set and slightly crisp, about 25 minutes. Cool & cut into 9 squares, Enjoy
