



# Tech-Tip: Lubrication Points Commonly Overlooked

Besides the 32-34 or so, grease fittings; a few other places that might need attention:

- 1. Upper distributor shaft: A drop or 2, 10W (3-In-One Oil)
- 2. Distributor cam and cam follower: A dab of vaselene.
- 3. Steering box: 600W Gear Lube (or equivalent gear lube). Not grease.
- 4. Horn: A drop of light oil (3-In-One) on the felt disk on the armature.
- 5. Hand Brake Actuator: The arm that fits through the rear brake shoe mounting plate. Some replacement arms are fitted with a grease zerk.
- 6. Speedometer cable:
- 7. Throw-out bearing slider—the zerk under the transmission cover; under the floor board infront of the shift lever.
- 8. Water pump: Front and rear bearings, (unless the pump has sealed bearings)
- 9. Throttle Linkage: Light oil.

By 1928 the cloche hat brim disappeared entirely, so between 1926 and 1929 asymmetric brims reduced often to nothing. To wear one correctly the hat had to be all but pulled over the eyes, making the wearer have to lift up the head, whilst peering snootily down the nose. Cloche hats had a basic bell contour with bulbous crowns which if correctly designed could add inches to the height of the wearer helping to foster the haughty look, so redolent of the cloche in our mind's eye.



Lady A's were treated to a presentation of vintage and Model A era "unmentionables" featuring Pauline Lawhorn's extensive collection.




#### Free Membership Program
